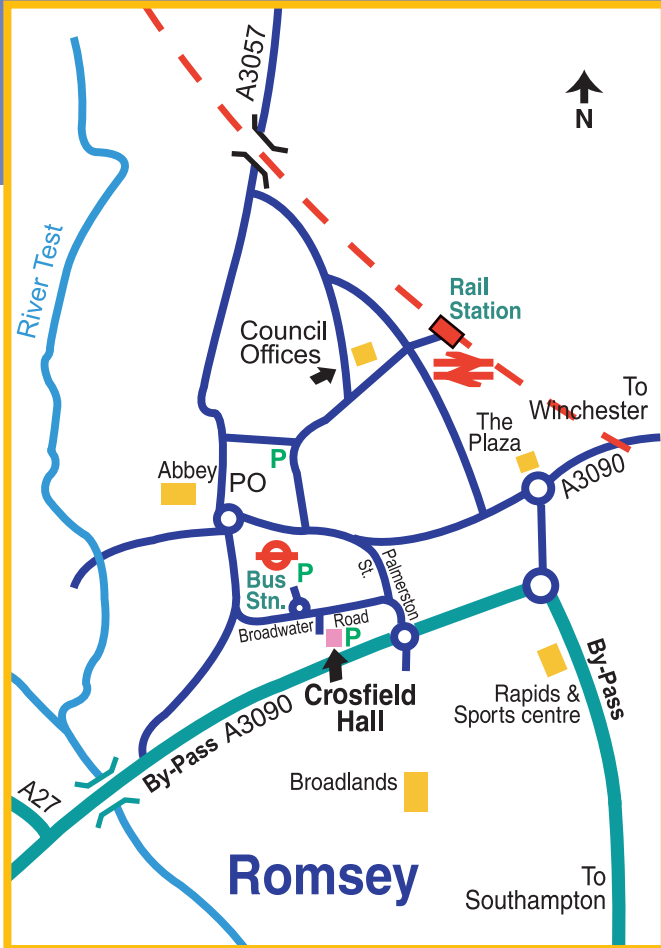


Crosfield Hall was built and donated by Mr J.J. Crosfield as a gift to the community of Romsey in 1935.



Leave the A3090 (opposite Broadlands Estate, entrance) into Palmerston Street. Bear left, into Broadwater Road. Then after the pedestrian crossing turn immediately left, and on your left is Crosfield Hall. The main entrance is at the rear. There are public (Pay & Display) car parking spaces on site.

The Nightingale and Berthon Rooms are ideal for business or private meetings. All four function rooms can be hired in conjunction with the main hall, or individually for smaller gatherings.

A range of equipment and training aids are also available.

Access

There is easy access for people with disabilities into and throughout the building except for the Nightingale and Berthon rooms. Also the stage, which is only accessible by 7 steps. Disabled parking and toilets are provided. The bus station is opposite and the historic town centre 3 minutes walk away.
