Gambledown Farm safari tents open onto the living, dining and kitchen area, where a wood-fired stove keeps the space lovely and warm in the chillier months. There's also a comfy sofa to relax on and a dining area.

Sleeping arrangements consist of a master bedroom with king sized bed and a second bedroom with the choice of either twins beds or

bed is tucked into the wall which easily sleeps two children. Each tent is fitted with an internal bathroom; a hot water shower, normal flushing loo and basin.

A fire pit for huddling round on tree stumps, toasting marshmallows is positioned outside, and a sizeable front deck, perfect for taking in the scenic views. Glamping essentials such as extra fire logs, coal, matches, firelighters, marshmallows, Gambledown meat, local cider, wine, local ice cream, and

tea & coffee can all be bought on site in our farm shop.

Gambledown Farm, practicing sustainable farming, is a traditional Hampshire mixed farm with a resident herd of over 30 Shorthorn cattle, arable crops and ancient woodland.


The Meadow is nestled in a quiet corner of Broughton, Hampshire, a two acre idyllic, peaceful, tucked away site, yet still close to the convenience of this typical English country village.

Whether you prefer to take the rowing boat for a short lap around the lake, play tennis on the grass court, or sit quietly reading a book by the lake, your time at The Meadow is your own to relax and enjoy the stunning setting as you wish.

There are three units Wild Billy's which is an original showmans wagon, Mary's place a converted wooden summer house and The Magic Rat an original 23ft Springer Narrow Boat, now moored by its own private island.



Each unit is spread over 2 acres which allows plenty of room to spread out and relax in your own private glamping area. Each



unit has its own bedroom, large outdoor area with seating, firepits and cooking facilities (including cover from the elements) and your own river side seating to watch the trout and ducklings cruise by on the Wallop Brook.

You may decide to cook amazingly tasty local buffalo burgers over the fire pit under the stars or you can opt to take a short stroll to the local pub for a meal or a tipple. Perhaps then finish your evening cosying up in front of the wood burner with a hot

chocolate, or a large glass of wine.


The beautifully hand crafted hut which sits on cast iron wheels in a field of its own was made by Blackdown (the finest manufacturer). It is clad in feather edged oak, insulated with sheep's wool, features hand crafted oak units and fittings, together with the magical pull-down double bed and en-suite shower.

The hut also has a log burner to keep you snug and warm. As if that is not enough, the stunning curved glass ceiling above the bed enables you can continue stargazing long into the night, wrapped up in your Hungarian goose down duvet.

Meadow Tree Farm Wild Camping Sherfield English SO51 6FG

Meadow tree farm is a working farm on the edge of the beautiful village of Sherfield English in Hampshire.

This working farm has devoted one of their fields and a part of their woodland to wild camping for those (over the age of 21) who wish to share this unique corner of Hampshire and really get back to nature.

Surrounded by some of the best of the British wildlife this birdwatchers paradise is ideal to watch the local Buzzards fight off the mobbing Rooks, if you're really lucky you may even catch a glimpse of the elusive Roe Deer. To maintain woodland peace for campers this is an adult only campsite and discourages large groups it is well-maintained, encompassed in woods, with a host of facilities available for campers to use. They offer a variety of large hard standing and grass pitches with water and electric hook ups available.

Pitches must be booked in advance and are suitable for Motorhomes, Caravans, Campervans and tents. They have newly updated shared facilities that get professionally cleaned on a regular basis. There are separate toilets for men and women, each with two showers and three toilets. There is also an outside sink with hot water for washing up and a chemical waste disposal point. Water and electric hook ups are available.

Situated in the heart of Hampshire, this quiet campsite is surrounded by scenic woodland walks and popular heritage sites. Within walking distance, you can explore the 1000 acres of Ampfield Woods, eat at the delicious White Horse pub or catch the bus (right outside) into the historic towns of Romsey or Winchester. It is just a short 2-minute drive from the beautiful Hillier's arboretum or a 15-minute drive to the coveted New Forest National Park.

Rowbury Farm Camping Goodworth Clatford SP11 7SD

45 large pitches non-electric pitches available on 11 acres, with fire pits provided that can be enjoyed free of charge. There are a block of toilets and showers in purpose-built units, which are of good quality and provided with hot water. The men's block is a shared facility with 2 showers, 2 toilets and some urinals. There is a large family unit with a shower and toilet. For the ladies there are two single-occupancy shower-toilet units and a separate toilet.

The washing up area has 2 large twin-basin stands. There are no fridges, freezers or charging facilities on site. Rowbury Farm

Camping is committed to having a low impact on the environment. Recycling is encouraged and all the waste is sorted at the depot with recyclable items being removed. Water comes from a private borehole on the farm, which is subject to denitrification and and is UV-treated, so is untainted by chemicals.

If you arrive by bike, on foot or roller-skates, they will give you a 10% discount.
