

Reuse organisations are in need of good quality household items to supply affordable goods to those in need:

## Here are our top tips for successfully donating your items for reuse!

- Store your item under cover to keep it protected from the weather.
- For sofas, mattresses, bed bases or upholstered chairs the fire safety label must remain in order to be used again:



- For sofas and armchairs - the label needs to state compliance with The Furniture and Furnishings (Fire Safety) Regulations 1988 (amended 1989 and 1993)



- Check before donating whether any unwanted toys have a CE mark on them. Safety Regulations 1988 (amended 1989 and 1993)



- Tables
- Chairs
- Wardrobes
- Chests of drawers
- Mattresses
- Armchairs
- Sofas
- Bed bases + frames

## There are many benefits to donating your unwanted items for reuse:

- It helps get rid of your unwanted items which can be at no cost to you!
- You are helping those families that really need it – one tonne of reused household goods can assist 15 low income households.



- You can help your local community buy essential household items at an affordable price - on average this saves each family £150 in buying new goods.


