
East Dean parish profile

East Dean is one of the 59 parishes in Test Valley. It has an area of 433 hectares which represents 0.7% of the total area of Test Valley.

Residents

The estimated 2016 population of East Dean parish is 227. This is expected to fall by 2021 to 221 (a fall of 2.6%).

East Dean 's resident population is 50.7% female and 49.3% male.


Young people (0-19) currently make up 24.7% of East Dean's population; this is expected to fall to 18.6% by 2021.

Young adults (20-39) currently make up 13.7% of the parish's population; this is expected to rise to 21.3% by 2021.

Middle aged residents (40-64) currently account for 35.7% of East Dean's population; this is expected to fall to 31.2% by 2021.

Those **aged 65 and over** make up 26.0% of the parish's population; this is expected to rise to 29.0% by 2021.

Those **aged 85 and over** currently represent 0.9% of the population; this is expected to rise to 3.2% by 2021.



Age of parish population






Ethnicity


The largest ethnic group in East Dean is "White" at 98.7% of the parish's population. That compares with a figure of 95.9% for Test Valley as a whole and 95.0% for Hampshire.

The second largest ethnic group (1.3%) is "Mixed/multiple ethnic groups". That compares with 1.3% for Test Valley as a whole and 1.4% for Hampshire.



Households

East Dean parish has **84 households**, which represent 0.2% of Test Valley's 47,626 households. The household split by tenure is shown below (tenure refers to the financial arrangements under which a home is occupied).








The majority of properties (77.4%) are **owned by those who live in them**. This is higher than the Test Valley average of 70.4%.

11.9% of East Dean households are **privately rented**, and 8.3% are **socially rented**. This compares to 12.9% and 14.4% respectively across Test Valley.



Households by number of residents

39.3% of East Dean's households are occupied by two people, and 21.4% by one person. 39.3% of the parish's households are occupied by more than two people.

East Deam has 6 households with **dependent children aged 0 to 4**. That represents 7.1% of the parish's households.

28 households in the parish have **dependent children of all ages**. That represents 33.3% of the parish's households.

House prices


According to Zoopla, the average house price in East Dean (as of September 2016) is **£751,369**. This has increased by 15.9% in the last five years.

It is estimated that **39.4% of households in central rural Test Valley cannot afford to buy a private property**. The central rural area includes the wards of Dun Valley, Blackwater, Broughton and Stockbridge, and Kings Somborne and Michelmersh.





Council Tax Bands



5.6% of East Dean properties are at the **lower** end of the property market (Bands A and B). This compares to 22.2% for Test Valley as a whole.

60.7% of the parish's properties are in the **middle** range of the property market (Bands C to E). This compares to 60.8% across the whole borough.


33.7% of East Dean's properties are at the **higher** end of the property market (Bands F to H). This compares to 17.1% of all Test Valley properties.





Education

43.9% of East Dean's residents have achieved **level 4 qualifications** and above compared to 30.5% in Test Valley as a whole. 16.4% of East Dean residents have **no qualifications** compared to 18.4% in Test Valley.




Employment

72.3% of East Dean residents aged 16-74 are **economically active**, compared to 73.4% of Test Valley residents. This includes people in full-, part- and self-employment, those who are actively seeking a job, and full-time students.

The remaining 27.7% of residents aged 16-74 are **economically inactive**, compared to 26.6% of Test Valley residents. This includes people who are retired, long-term sick or disabled, or who look after the home and family.


East Dean has 5 (2.2%) residents that report being in **bad health** and 1 (0.4%) residents that report being in **very bad health**.


