Resource Sheet - Milk Bottle Elephant



Follow these simple steps to turn a milk bottle into an elephant. With help from a grown up to cut the bottle, this craft is perfect for little hands.



You will need:

- ★ An empty and clean 2 pint or 4 pint milk bottle
- ★ Scissors
- ★ Marker pen
- ★ PVA glue
- \star Coloured paper, stickers, stick on eyes for decoration

Method

1) Draw your elephant

Lay your milk bottle on its side and look at it carefully, can you see an elephant shape? Using your marker pen, drawn the shape of your elephant on both sides of the bottle. Use the handle as a trunk and draw arches for the legs.





2) Cut out

Using scissors, carefully cut around the lines. It can be easier to cut around the entire bottle first to remove the bottom part of the bottle which can be recycled.



Join in. Recycle. Be a Recycling Star

3) Decorate

Using PVA glue, stick scraps of paper to the bottle to decorate.



4) Add eyes and ears

Add eyes.



Draw 2 ears onto your chosen paper, cut out and stick on.
