The Council will only process your personal data where it is lawful to do so. We will not be able to deal with your application to fish at Rooksbury Mill without processing your data.

You can withdraw your consent at any time and ask us to remove you from our records.. We will not share your information with any third parties. Any information sharing is managed in accordance with data protection legislation. Your contact information will be retained for six years post the issue of your licence and then it will be deleted. We may contact you with regard to any queries about the Fishing Permit and may contact you before expiry of your current permit to invite renewal. We will contact you throughout the season with information regarding fishing and any information regarding your temporary Parking Permit.

The Council will only process your information for the purpose for which it was collected i.e. to process your application for a fishing permit and accompanying parking permit. The Council will not transfer your personal information outside of the European Economic Area (EEA) and will not use your personal information for any automated decision making.
