2.11, 6.4, 8.1	<p>The Trust, as a statutory consultee within the planning system and source of advice and guidance on theatre projects, would be keen to be engaged in any plans being prepared for Lights in Andover as part of the Masterplan for Andover. Similarly we would note that although investment into the Plaza in Romsey is welcomed it is disappointing the Council failed to consult with the Trust or notify us of the relevant planning application despite it falling within our remit. Please ensure officers are made aware of our role and their obligations.</p> <p>More generally, we would encourage the plan to positively promote the role of cultural facilities in supporting the vitality of town centres. We also recommend inclusion of policy protecting Test Valley's valued facilities from unnecessary loss so the plan accords with paragraph 92 of the NPPF.</p>
