	<p>The computerised form etc of this consultation, makes it difficult for those not fully familiar or conversant with technology, to access all the information.</p> <p>I therefore post our general comments below...</p> <p>My wife & I have lived in Test Valley Councils area of Valley Park since the mid-1980s. (ie. Nearly 40 years).</p> <p>Our main concern is to maintain the undeveloped area of woodland & fields north of and alongside Castle Lane, between Valley Park, Chandlers-ford, and the outskirts of North-Baddesley. We also have similar concerns re the land on the southern side of Castle Lane, towards Chilworth. These areas support much local wildlife, including deer, and other creatures.</p> <p>We are also concerned about the land north of Valley Park, around Flexford, between the railway line and Flexford Road/Baddesley Road. There was a previous plan, since abandoned we think, to continue Knightwood Road north from the Flexford roundabout, to serve a future development. This land, in our humble opinion, should not be developed for building, as it is a country barrier between established existing built-up areas.</p>
