RURAL RATE RELIEF SCHEME RURAL SETTLEMENT LIST SECTION 42A LOCAL GOVERNMENT FINANCE ACT 1988

Rural Rate Relief is available to certain businesses in designated rural areas with populations under 3,000. Unless otherwise indicated rural areas are based on parish boundaries.

From 1 April 2017, rate relief of 100% can be granted provided the business is:

- the <u>only</u> general store, food shop (excluding catering premises) or post office in a qualifying rural settlement, with a rateable value of £8,500 or less, or
- the <u>only</u> public house or petrol filling station in a qualifying rural settlement, with a rateable value of £12,500 or less.

Test Valley Borough Council also has the power to grant discretionary rural rate relief of up to 100% to any business in a qualifying rural settlement which the Council considers to be of benefit to the local community, with a rateable value of £16,500 or less, and that it is considered reasonable to grant such relief having regard to the interest of all its Council Taxpayers.

The following list identifies the qualifying rural settlements in the Test Valley Borough Council area effective for the financial year 2024-2025. The list is reviewed annually and is published by 31st December each year in respect of the following financial year.
