## RESPONSE TO THE REGULATION 18 DRAFT TEST VALLEY LOCAL PLAN 2040 PUBLIC CONSULTATION

Further to my letter of the 20<sup>th</sup> July 2020, entitled: comments on the refined issues and options consultation for the next local plan

Thank you for your email of the 11<sup>th</sup> February 2022 and the opportunity to respond to the consultation. Having considered the draft Test Valley Local Plan 2040 I have the following comments to make with reference to prevention of crime and disorder<sup>1</sup>.

I would ask, that the following amendments are made to the draft Test Valley Local Plan 2040:

- 1. Paragraph 4.46, the word "enhance" is amended to "provide for" and "anti-social behaviour" is amended to "disorder (anti-social behaviour)"
- 2. Strategic Policy 2, sub paragraph D, is amended to include the following: (or with words so as to convey the same meaning): "Development will take all opportunities to create an environment that minimises the opportunities for crime and disorder (anti-social behaviour). All development must demonstrate compliance with the Secured by Design principles."

3. Strategic Policy 4, sub paragraph e, is amended from "to minimise opportunities for anti-social behaviour and crime" to "to minimise opportunities for crime and disorder (anti-social behaviour)".
