The construction of houses on this land is the natural progression and expansion of Valley Park.

The farmland at Velmore Farm is fundamentally no different from that at Knightwood Farm, Zionshill Farm or Titlark Farm prior to the existing elements of Valley Park being built.

However, road access via the school lane roundabout may need to be rethought. The possibility of traffic feeding into the current castle lane / templars way / knightwood road crossroads, with that junction changed to a roundabout, could be considered. Alternatively, an option to exit on the south western end of the site, over adjoining land and onto an improved Misslebrook lane with a reworked junction between Misslebrook lane and the A27 could be considered.
