This part of Test Valley is already very overpopulated and the infrastructure cannot sustain any further housing developments. There are frequent traffic jams along Templars Way, and more than a fair share of collisions. We already have way too many cars on the roads in and around the Chandlers Ford area. Another 2000+ vehicles entering and exiting from Templars Way is totally unacceptable. Another issue, because of the fields and existing roads and poor drainage, there are already frequent floods around the roundabout intersecting with School Lane and further along School Lane. The building of a further 1000+ houses on this undulating land will only make the problem worse.

In addition, huge pressures already on local healthcare services, schools, gyms, leisure Centres etc make this a completely unsuitable location for development and the loss of ever decreasing green space. This must not happen. I strongly object to this proposal.
