I wish to object to the proposed development of the 'Land at Velmore Farm'as described in the 'Draft Test Valley Local Plan 2040 Regulation 18 Stage 2'

My primary objection consists of the impact of the increased traffic on Templars Way, School Lane and Castle Lane. These roads are already highly congested at morning and evening rush hour times and the additional traffic created by the proposed 1070 homes and other facilities will greatly exacerbate this, especially as I note that the main access to the site is intended to be via the roundabout at the south end of School Lane.

A secondary objection is due to the increased risk of flooding due to run-off from the site. For many years the roundabout at the south end of school lane frequently floods, with the run-off running down the School Lane beyond the pelican crossing about 400m north of the roundabout. School Lane is frequently flooded across the full width of the road at this point. There is also routinely flooding on the western Templars Way exit from the roundabout. We have suffered this flooding for many years with no solution ever forthcoming from TVBC to address it.

I also wish to strongly object to the breach of the local gap, as described in section 4.137 of your document.
