The increase in traffic is already significant and now we are going to add another 1,000 car movements in a small area. How will the roads cope? The local people have had two huge developments and now it looks like a 3rd further impacting the pollution and the quality of life of residents.

It seems to me that other areas south or east of Romsey centre, would be more suitable, this would allow traffic to get to the M27 without having to block the roads in and out of Romsey. Why is it the same areas every time?

There would also have to be money spent on health care, getting a doctors appointment is bad enough without another huge influx of people. Where is the funding for the support of all these people going to come from?

There will be huge impact to the wildlife, where are the deer going to go? the bats? birds etc?

Lastly DWH haven't engaged with local residents at any stage of this proposal and despite being promised contact when they had a display at the sports centre we haven't heard from them. Parcel D is literally behind my Garden and we haven't been considered in any shape or form despite this having a huge impact on our life.
