This is in relation to the development of southern Test Valley Nursling proposal Local plan 2024

I have real concerns for this development due to the destruction of a green field site and the development of a woodland that houses bluebells and various other important wide life. This should be preserved

We have already lost a lot of trees along Romsey road when the motor way was built. I feel very distressed that more trees and green field sites will be lost, with a again a huge impact on wide life.

Also the field that you propose to build on contains electric two pylons, which is not suitable for houses to be built on within such close proximity these pylons.

The sale of these properties will be a concern to any potential buyers living under these.

There is a huge health risk if these plans go ahead. Its is found that children living in homes as far away as 600m are at a higher risk for leukaemia, and other major health risks to anyone living near these.

I live opposite this site and I'm very concerned about the noise and traffic and light pollution, that will be created.

Nursling and Rownhams has had such a large development in recent years, and the traffic and damage to our area is very concerning.

I believe that industrial units will be built within this proposal, this is also going to create more heavy lorries and coming into Nursling.

Just travelling around Southampton, you can see several industrial units empty, and to build more is completely unjustified

This will also have a detrimental effect on the value of all the existing properties close to this development.
