General

- 1/ We live close to the golf course on Ramsey Rd. The traffic from 7.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m. is non-stop as cars/lorries exit the M27 to approach Southampton via the Ramsey Rd. It is impossible to cross the road on foot. ~~Cars~~ Cars already back up Upton Lane trying to get onto the Ramsey Rd. It is virtually impossible exiting from our driveway onto the Ramsey Rd!
The reverse happens come hometime. This is the situation NOW without more building works.
 - 2/ The need is for first time buyers homes we do not want more detached 4/5. houses. There is not enough homes for young families. Families would need to afford two cars as there are NO BUSES, only to Mountbatten/Ramsey schools for teenagers. For younger children it would be 6 mile round trip for mums (or dads) and 3 miles for children to walk to the junior schools.
 - 3/ The local wildlife would be impacted - we regularly see deer and foxes in the field opposite. There are Badgers and Hedge hogs. One morning I was distressed to find no less than four squashed on the road by the traffic.
 - 4/ The copse on the motorway side of Upton Lane have wonderful bluebells and is home to many birds. The deer access and live there.
- There are woods on the 'Bridal Path' adjacent to the golf course. It is not well kept. In winter it is a muddy quagmire and cannot be used.

8/	There are stables and horses who use Upton Lane to access the woods. It is hard now for them to cross the main Romsey Rd.

9/ Sometimes the main M27 motorway is closed for essential highway maintenance. The traffic is diverted past our houses and huge lorries thunder past shaking our foundations.
