Heat generated by 20/30 KV cables is very high energy requires to be disbursed for them to function

To situate 20/30 KV cables underground means massive civil engineering works comprising Large air circulating ducts and means of hot air extraction.

Cost prohibitive and probably due to duct size (Surrounding Air Volume) capacity and mechanical heat extraction needed – Impractical.
