With reference to the TVBC planning proposal for land at Upton Lane, Nursling, we wish to object for the following reasons. The junction with Upton Lane and Romsey Road already has resulted in many accidents as vehicles also emerge from the golf course opposite. Any development would result in an increase in vehicles.

Despite all the development that has taken place in Nursling and Rownhams in the last few years there has been no improvements to the infrastructure to cope with the increasing population. There used to be regular buses along Romsey Road to Romsey and Southampton, now there are none and as residents of the area we have to rely on being able to drive.

Upton Lane would need to be widened as there is no footpath for much of it which would affect the rural habitat.

There would be an increase in noise, light and air pollution, the area already has the motorway nearby.
