I believe it is critical to maintain existing settlement boundaries around Fishlake Meadow Nature Reserve and the scenic canal path per the current Local Plan.

The Local Plan protects open countryside and should continue to do so. By moving the boundaries you are allowing further over development along Cupernham Lane and consequential urban sprawl will physically and permanently harm the visual character of countryside surrounding Fishlake Meadows Nature Reserve.

This is unnecessary building as with other developments already agreed and plans submitted within Romsey town/area the 'quota' has already been reached and therefore should be prevented by maintaining current local plan boundaries.

Particular land to the North of Oxlease Meadows is not designated within the current development plan and lies beyond settlement boundaries. It is an open countryside location and the updated local plan should protect this and sustain wildlife.

Any development will permanently alter the character of Fishlake Meadows Nature Reserve. The canal and footpath are used extensively and form an important part of the visual character, with any development impacting negatively and permanently on this.

This would result in loss of - much loved local amenity and alter the tranquil character of Fishlake Meadows Nature Reserve.
