I am strongly opposed to the proposal contained within the Test Valley Local plan 2040 which proposes residential development on Velmore Farm in Valley Park. The proposal is for a number of houses covering an area similar in size to the current Knightwood Park. Therefore the scale of this development cannot be underestimated.

Whilst I fully appreciate that the local authority must make plans for their residents for the future the proposed site is not suitable. There is a proposal for one entrance to the new site off Templars Way. Templars Way is already congested at times and will not cope with the demands of additional traffic. School Lane, Castle Lane and Knightwood Road are simply not able to cope with this additional traffic either

There is a flooding issue on School Lane and at the roundabout of School Lane and Templars Way this will simply be exacerbated by development on the proposed site. It has become clear recently that developers and the local authority do not take into account the way in which the drainage is so detrimentally affected by development.

I note that the plan has acknowledged the requirement for an additional primary school in order to meet demand, however the need for an additional Doctor or Dentist has been neglected.
