Firstly at present, much run off of rainwater from the fields earmarked in the plan ends up flooding the roundabout at the junction of Templars Way and School Lane, if the current proposal for housing is implemented then the run off will vastly increase due to the reduced ability of the land to soak up the rainwater and hence the flooding will get worse.

Secondly traffic in Templars way is very busy and often gridlocked along School Lane and between the Asda roundabout and the traffic lights at Castle Lane/ Templars Way adding extra traffic from the main access point would add a vast increase in traffic meaning more congestion and hence pollution.

Overall it seems obvious that these problems have not been properly assessed and the plan needs to be scrapped.
