With reference to the above Stopping Order, I would like to lodge an objection due to the following factors:-

The Stopping Order was published in the London Gazette on 16th October 2025 and also in The Salisbury Journal which is Wiltshire based and not a Hampshire Newspaper which I discovered by chance as I was expecting the Stopping Order to be published in the Andover Advertiser and did not find it in this Newspaper which would be considered the Local Newspaper for SP10 Post Code.

I am the Resident Lodge Manager of Chantry Lodge and reside at the Lodge.

It is my responsibility to take charge of the wellbeing and safety of all the Owners who reside at Chantry Lodge, many of whom are elderly but the proposed scheme would increase traffic movements outside the Lodge, increase danger to Pedestrians as they would now have to cross two lanes of Traffic. Currently the Shoppers to Lidl use the Top entrance, but under this proposal would now have to come and go down West street thereby doubling the traffic flow. Also, the Lidl Delivery Trucks would now have to use this proposed road and the Buses would have to make a return journey past the Lodge thereby doubling the amount of Bus Traffic.

Also, with the increased traffic Volume the noise level would also increase affecting the tranquillity that my Owners bought into when they purchased their Retirement Apartments at Chantry Lodge.

When Planning permission was obtained to change the Retail Shops into Apartments, the planning permission was granted on condition that the Pavement was enlarged to allow for increased pedestrian traffic from the Sixth Form College and so the pavement was increased and the much needed Loading Bay (which would be used for unloading Parcels and allow Ambulances to park safely) was removed. The current proposal seems to completely reverse those reasons as the Pavement would be lost to make way for the project.

It is for the above reasons that I strongly object to the Stopping Up Order.
