ABBOTSWOOD PUBLIC ART PROJECT KICKS OFF WITH THE ART BUS IN ROMSEY

Test Valley Borough Council has commissioned local artist Nicola Henshaw to sculpt a creative trail of public art to link Romsey to Abbotswood.

Nicola specialises in wood sculptures and is seeking ideas and inspiration for designs from local residents. She will be hosting a series of community events during the next few months to gather as many thoughts and concepts as possible. The aim of the project is to design a trail of sculptures, benches, stepping stones and storytelling panels that will create a sense of place and connect the Abbotswood development to existing communities in Romsey.

The first community event took place on Saturday 17 October in Romsey town centre. Members of the public came on board the Art Bus to meet Nicola and her creative team and shared their memories, thoughts and feelings about living and working in Romsey and the surrounding area.

Community and Leisure Portfolio Holder, Councillor Tony Ward, said: "We are looking forward to supporting Nicola to create a beautiful series of artworks in the local area. The project has been funded by Section 106 contributions from the Abbotswood development and will support the Council's corporate priority to provide opportunities for residents to contribute to and be part of a strong community."

WRITING FOR RADIO AND PODCASTING WITH ANGIE



'I have been battling with Severe Depression over the last three years. Part of my treatment has been Electroconvulsive Therapy; seizures are electronically induced to provide relief from psychiatric illnesses. This treatment was effective for me in part and has led to a new train of thought around Memory. My memory has been affected by the ECT, this is an expected side effect. I am starting to work on pieces to explore the processing, the continuity, the blurring, the loss, memory recall and the representation of memory.' Joanne Pudney

A CALL OUT FOR THE VOICES OF ANDOVER

An exciting new local project is just about to begin called Voices of Andover, and it wants your input!



Commissioned by New Dimensions, Voices of Andover aims to give local people the opportunity to work with composer John K Miles to create a new piece of choral music that will draw on the stories, experiences and memories of Andover residents.

The project is calling for schools, community groups, local businesses and residents of all singing abilities to join them and help create a piece of music through a series of collaborative workshops at The Lights Theatre, Andover beginning in November, ready for a grand debut performance in March 2016.

John K Miles is a successful composer of numerous film and television scores who has written prolifically for theatre, jazz groups, world music ensembles, and the classical concert hall. He is a professor at The Guildhall School of Music and Drama.

The project is part of New Dimensions, a major music initiative being delivered in key areas of Hampshire; led jointly by Anvil Arts, Basingstoke and Turner Sims Concert Hall, Southampton, and funded by Hampshire County Council.
