




TVBC collect kerbside rubbish from

Augusta Park Bike Event – June 16th 2012

To celebrate National Bike Week a Family Bike



Event was held for residents at Augusta Park on Saturday morning. The rain held off but the conditions were extremely blustery! Cyclists from 'Behind The Bike Shed' cycle shop in Andover led a family cycle ride from the development and around Anton Lakes, which was an off road route suitable for all levels of cyclists.

Residents were able to make a Fruit Smoothie using the Smoothie Bike, have their bikes cycle coded for security, complete an Cycle Maintenance Checklist and have a go at a Cycle Quiz.

Consultation at the event showed that residents were very happy with the local infrastructure at East Anton - footpaths and cycle routes- and found them easy to access.

Travel Plan meeting

A resident meeting to discuss local travel infrastructure at East Anton was held on June 21st at the Community Centre. Annie Tomlinson (TVBC Transport Planner) and Helen Jones (HCC – School Travel Planner) came along to provide information about the development and plans for future sustainable travel at East Anton.

We are grateful to the two residents who attended the meeting and provided valuable feedback and ideas for the area.

We hope to arrange an update meeting in November 2012, to which all residents are welcome to attend.

Bus Service at East Anton

Once the northern spine road at Augusta Park is operational and / or the bus arch linking Cricketers Way and River Way is accessible to buses, there will be an improved, designated bus service for Augusta Park. This service will evolve as the development grows. The aspiration is that no home will be more than 400 meters from a bus stop situated on the spine roads throughout the development.

East Anton Subsidised Bus Pass Scheme

Residents are reminded that the developers at East Anton have funded 'Andover Area Mega Rider' subsidised bus passes for new households, which cover the Andover town area. Contact Sharon for an application form and details about the scheme.

Smannell Road Diversion

Aeropark have commenced construction of the roundabout at the junction of Smannell Road & Finkley Road which is necessary for the Smannell Road diversion to be completed. Works are expected to take 16 weeks.



Cycle vouchers

New homeowners are eligible for a £50 cycle voucher to spend on cycling accessories at Halfords from the developers (one voucher available per home). For details contact Sharon.

Parking

Please use your allocated parking spaces to park your vehicles. Cars parked on a pavement and road side make it difficult for pedestrians to walk and cross the road safely. This can be especially dangerous for children. Emergency services such as fire engines could also find it difficult to access some roads/ houses, where residents have parked inconsiderately.

Vehicles parked on pavements which are causing an obstruction should be reported to the police using the 101 number.

Endeavour School

Endeavour School was officially opened by Dame Mary Fagan on June 22nd. Celebrations included tours around the school led by pupils, official opening of the Solar Dome Garden and Celebration Cake!

Endeavour has over 120 children on roll with a maximun intake of reception year children expected in September 2012.

A school Travel Plan is being developed with the aim of keeping children safe on their way to and from school with consideration given to local residents, parking and access.

Adventure Pre School

A new pre-school called 'Adventure' will open five mornings a week on site at Endeavour School in September 2012. This will offer Early Education funded places for children of families in the community, from the term after they are 3 years old.
