Community Travel

Stagecoach buses are able to offer residents of Augusta Park a further 10% discount on bus passes once their yearly subsidised bus pass scheme has expired, followed by a 5% discount for the second year. Details explaining how residents can take up this offer will be provided when they apply for their last quarterly bus pass.



Education

The permanent building for Endeavour Primary School is progressing well and is expected to be ready for occupation January 2012.

Recreation & Open Space

Following the receipt of funding from the developer, Test Valley Borough Council is now responsible for the future maintenance of the central open space area.

Transport

Construction works on a new roundabout at the northern vehicle access into the development at the junction of Icknield Way and Viking Way are expected to start soon. The works are due to be completed by the end of November 2011.

In order to make the area safer for pedestrians, a Traffic Regulation Order to restrict the passage of vehicles on part of Icknield Way between Lillywhite Crescent and Viking Way to buses only is currently being advertised.
