



East Anton (Augusta Park)

Occupations

Latest figures obtained from the sales office showed that as of 31st May 2010 158 homes were occupied at Augusta Park. This figure includes 25 MOD properties. The remaining 21 MOD homes are expected to be occupied by the end of July.

Affordable Housing

Latest figures obtained from the sales office showed that as of 31st May 2010 71 affordable homes were occupied at Augusta Park.

Community

On Saturday June 26th from 10.30am - 12 noon,

Test Valley Borough Council will be holding a community event to promote the cycle routes in and around the East Anton area and to officially open the new Play Park on the open green area between Smannell Road & Hedgerow Walk.

There will be information for residents about the development, local area and cycle routes in Andover along with Healthy Living Promotion.

At 11.00am the Mayor of Test Valley, Chris Lynn, will officially open the Play Park. To coincide with National Bike Week, Roger Upfold, the Andover and Northern Test Valley representative for the Right to Ride Network, will lead a short, family cycle ride from the site to the nearby Tesco Store, River Way and back. The cycle ride will start at 11.15am from the Play Park and will follow an off road route which is suitable for those wanting to locate nearby facilities by bike.

Transport

The Public Inquiry into the Section 247 Stopping Up Order for part of Smannell Road is due to commence at The Lights in Andover on 20 July and is expected to last a week. Works to the Enham Arch Roundabout and A343 Corridor are likely to commence in July.

Education

The new school, to be called '**Endeavour Primary School**', will open in September 2010 in temporary accommodation with a permanent build hoped for in early 2012. The school will be run as a federation with Roman Way School and Knights Enham School, led by Ann Hughes. Details on the school day start and finishing times are currently being discussed and interviews for teachers and staff are being held in July. Public Open Space

The children's play park located on the open space to the north of Smannell Road is now open, although the official opening will be held on 26th June as outlined above. The community playing fields at the north of the site have been laid out.
